As the deadline for contractors to be trained and certified in lead-safe work practices approaches (April 22, 2010) BHHBA is offering a course on this topic.

The Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) rule affects contractors, property managers and others who disturb or know of presumed lead-based paint during renovation. The term renovation covers all activities done for compensation that disturb painted surfaces including most repair, remodeling and maintenance activities, such as window replacement, weatherization and demolition. The RRP rule applies to all renovation work performed in residential houses, apartments and child-occupied facilities such as schools and daycare centers built before 1978. Firms must have one or more "Certified Renovators" assigned to jobs where lead-based paint is disturbed.
